Snowy Pisang Peak Climbing

Altitude: **6,092 Meters**, Duration: **15/18 Days**, Grade: **Strenuous technical Climbing**

Overview:

“Catch us on an unforgettable trip to Pisang Peak – one of the ‘most spectacular trekking peaks’ in Nepal. Conveniently located in the Annapurna region, the climb can be easily combined with a trekking tour of the region.”

Pisang Peak (6092 m.) is considered as one of the easier but technical climbing peaks among the trekking peaks in Annapurna Region of Nepal. The Pisang Peak has majestically stood up above the village of Pisang & has formed the shape of pyramid in the summit. Pisang Peak lies on the way to the highest pass of the world “Throng La Pass” & offers very good scope for exploration.

For *Pisang Peak Climbing* the trekking starts from drive via Besisahar to Dharapani and trek in the Valley of the Marsyangdi River toward Chame. The diversity of flora and fauna along the trail of this Annapurna Region until reaching the Pisang peak are incredible. Firstly, we departure to Besisahar from Katmandu and take 4/WD to Dharapani then start trek enroot common Annapurna Circuit trails and reach Pisang in 3 days. A Kharka at 4380m is considered the best place for setting up the base camp for Pisang Peak to ascent. The paths toward the summit of Pisang Peak ascend through wood and pasture and ultimately reach to the Kharka. The high camp for this Pisang Peak Climbing is set up at (5,400m) climbing to a shoulder on the South-West Ridge. There will be snow at the high camp from the end of November to the end of March. The well-defined ridge leads to the final snow slop, which is quite steep and little difficult to reach the summit of Peak Pisang.

The summit of the Pisang Peak offers truly splendid views of the Annapurna Range like Tilicho Peak, Annapurna II and IV, Ghangapurna and the Glacier Dome. Thus indeed, it is a peak of Sightseeing of snow-capped mountains of the Area. After a successful summit, the descent is made through same route and trek continued to Manang valley and proceeds further up to Throng Pedi, cross a Throng La pass 5416m and approach to Muktinath, the another part of the Annapurna Region. Next Day you will descent trek to Jomsom to wait for an adventurous 20 minutes flight back to Pokhara.

Hence Team Snowy Horizon offers full board package for this Pisang Peak climbing as a unique adventure including climbing permit from NMA and all other necessary logistics form arrival up to departure from Kathmandu. Upon your request we do also offer only base camp service of this peak climbing where the climber may arrange all required logistics for above the base camp. Yet, the company provides the peak permit. The route of this trekking and climbing lies in Annapurna Region is also known as Annapurna Conservation Area.

We invite both the climbers requiring full board service or base camp service for this Pisang Peak Climbing. Our service includes the proper maps of the trekking and climbing route, hygienic high altitude food cooked freshly by our experienced cooks, experienced and professional trekking and climbing Sherpa’s and guides, sufficient and quality logistics, properly arranged arrival and departure transfers, well managed accommodation and tours to Kathmandu and Pokhara Valley.

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Day-to -Day Itinerary (Direct up & down): (Option 1)

- Day 01:** Arrival in Kathmandu-Transfer to Hotel.
Day 02: Permit issue, preparation, last minute shopping and briefing.
Day 03: Drive to Besisahar (760m-6/7 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 04: Jeep drive to Dharapani (1650m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 05: Trek from Dharapani to Chame (2670m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 06: Trek from Chame to Upper Pisang (3300m-6 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 07: Trek from Upper Pisang to Pisang Peak Base Camp (4573m-5 Hrs.); camping.
Day 08: Trek from Pisang Peak Base Camp to High Camp (5030m-5 Hrs.); camping.
Day 09: **Attempt the summit of Pisang Peak (6092m-10 Hrs.); and back to BC; camping.**
Day 10: Contingency day for bad weather condition.
Day 11: Trek from Pisang Peak Base Camp to Manang (3540m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 12: Trek from Manang to Chame (6 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 13: Drive to Besisahar via Dharapani by sharing jeep (6 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 14: Drive back to Kathmandu – 7 Hrs; transfer to Hotel.
Day 15: Final departure to your port of destination.

Day-to -Day Itinerary (Combined with Throng La Pass Trek): (Option 2)

- Day 01:** Arrival in Kathmandu-Transfer to Hotel.
Day 02: Permit issue, preparation, last minute shopping and briefing.
Day 03: Drive to Besisahar (760m-6/7 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 04: Jeep drive to Dharapani (1650m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 05: Trek from Dharapani to Chame (2670m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 06: Trek from Chame to Upper Pisang (3300m-6 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 07: Trek from Upper Pisang to Pisang Peak Base Camp (4573m-5 Hrs.); camping.
Day 08: Trek from Pisang Peak Base Camp to High Camp (5030m-5 Hrs.); camping.
Day 09: **Attempt the summit of Pisang Peak (6091m-10 Hrs.); and back to BC; camping.**
Day 10: Contingency day for bad weather condition.
Day 11: Trek from Pisang Peak Base Camp to Manang (3540m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 12: Trek from Manang to Ledar (4050m-6 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 13: Trek from Lather to Throng Phedi (4540m-6 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 14: Trek via Throng-La Pass (5416m) to Muktinath (3710m-9 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 15: Trek from Muktinath to Jomsom (2720m-5 Hrs.) via Kagbeni; lodge.
Day 16: Fly from Jomsom to Pokhara (20 minutes), explore Pokhara city; Hotel.

Service Include:

- All arrival and departure transfers to and from Airports.
- 3 Nights hotel accommodations in Kathmandu on BB Plan.
- 1 night Hotel accommodation in Pokhara on BB plan.
- Experienced trekking guide (s) and 1:1 porter (s) during the trekking carrying 30kg maximum weight.
- Experienced and certified peak climbing Sherpa as per required.
- Surface transportation for Kathmandu-Besisahar-Dharapani & VV or Pokhara to Kathmandu.
- Jomsom-Pokhara flight tickets to all members and guide and surface to the porter (s).
- Base camp camping equipment like camp furniture, kitchenware, tents, etc.
- 3 meals a day (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) & sharing teahouse accommodation during trekking.





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- 3 meals a day (BLD with tea or coffee) and sharing tented camp accommodation during climbing at BC.
- Necessary high altitude food for climbing member and Sherpa for high camps.
- Annapurna Conservation Area entry fees and TIMS (Trekking Information Management System) card.
- Climbing permit for Pisang Peak from Nepal Mountaineering Association (NMA).
- All wages, equipment, medical and accidental Insurances for the involved staffs.
- First Aid medical kits for the Group and the staffs.
- Required fixed and dynamic rope during climbing period through climbing Sherpa.
- All necessary paper works, and Government Taxes levied in Nepal
- Complete pre-departure information, flight ticket reconfirmation.
- Farewell dinner in a typical Nepali restaurant with domestic culture show in Kathmandu.
