Snowy Chulu Far East Peak Climbing

Overview:

"Catch us on an unforgettable trip to Chulu East Peak (far East) – one of the 'most spectacular trekking peaks' in Nepal. Conveniently located in the Annapurna region, the climb can be easily combined with a trekking tour of the region."

Climbing Chulu East Peak (6,584m) with Team Snowy Horizon is a great way to spice up your trek in the Annapurna region. It lies just south east of its complement Chulu East provides breathtaking views of the Annapurna range, the Glacier Dome, Dhaulagiri, Tilicho Peak and Mt. Manaslu. The climbing involves some technical difficulties especially related to crossing large glacier sections. Familiarity with the use of crampons, ice axe as well as previous experience with roped glacier crossing is essential.

The history of its first ascent is somewhat murky with a German expedition ascending a summit in the Chulu group in 1955, which could have been either Chulu East or Chulu Far East. A confirmed ascent of Chulu East was completed in 1979. The conditions of the glacier have changed over the years but the fantastic panorama on the summit is still the same. The approach to the Chulu East Peak base camp starts with the drive (in a private vehicle) to Besi Sahar and 4 Wheel drive up to Dharapani in a grabbled highway from where the trek shall start toward the Ngawal via Chame. The diversity of flora and fauna along the trail of the Annapurna Region until reaching the Chulu East Peak is incredible as the French have already noted in their famous 1950 Annapurna expedition. Our Chulu East package includes the climb as well as the trek before and after. Chulu East Peak itself can be reached within a week. After climbing Chulu East, we make our way up the Throng La pass at over 5200m; then down into the spectacular Multinath; another part of the Annapurna Region. We then start the descent to Jomsom for an adventurous 20 minute flight back to Pokhara.

Snowy Horizon offers you a full board package including the climbing permit from the NMA and all other necessary logistics from arrival in Kathmandu up to your departure. We organize your accommodation in Kathmandu, Pokhara as well as throughout your trek, our cooks freshly prepare you the nutritious meals throughout the climbing period and experienced and professional trekking and climbing guides accompany you on the trek as well as the climb. In addition, we can organize any sightseeing in and around Kathmandu as well as the Pokhara valley. Upon your request, we can also offer only base camp service (including the climbing permit) where the climber may arrange all required logistics for any part of the climb above base camp.

The package can be flexibly adjusted to your requirements. Please feel free to contact us any time for suggestions and advice. We shall be happy to take you on this adventure upon your desire.



Snowy Chulu Far East Peak Climbing- Spring

Day-to -Day Itinerary (Direct up and Down): (Option 1)

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu-Transfer to Hotel.
Day 02: Permit issue, preparation, last minute shopping and briefing.
Day 03: Drive to Besisahar (760m-6/7 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 04: Jeep drive to Dharapani (1650m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 05: Trek from Dharapani to Chame (2670m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 06: Trek from Chame to Lower Pisang (3200m-6 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 07: Trek from Lower Pisang to Ngawal (3660m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
Day 08: Trek from Ngawal to Yak Kharka (3840m-5 Hrs.); teahouse.









- Day 10-11: Climb to High camp; and summit Chulu Far East (6059m), back to BC; camping. Day 12: Contingency day in Base Camp for weather, camping.
- Day 13: Trek from BC to Yak Kharka (3 Hrs.); teahouse.
- Day 14: Trek from Yak Kharka to Chame (7 Hrs.); lodge.
- **Day 15:** Drive to Besisahar via Dharapani by sharing jeep (6 Hrs.); lodge.
- **Day 16:** Drive back to Kathmandu 7 Hrs; transfer to Hotel.
- Day 17: Final departure to your port of destination.

Day-to -Day Itinerary (With Throng La Pass Trekking) : (Option 2)

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu-Transfer to Hotel.



Day 03: Drive to Besisahar (760m-6/7 Hrs.); lodge. Day 04: Jeep drive to Dharapani (1650m-5 Hrs.); lodge.

- Day 05: Trek from Dharapani to Chame (2670m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
- Day 06: Trek from Chame to Lower Pisang (3200m-6 Hrs.); lodge.
- Day 07: Trek from Lower Pisang to Ngawal (3660m-5 Hrs.); lodge.
- Day 08: Trek from Ngawal to Yak Kharka (3840m-5 Hrs.); teahouse.
- Day 09: Trek from Yak Kharka to Chulu Far East base camp (4950m-3 Hrs.); camping.
- Day 10-11: Climb to High camp; and summit Chulu Far East (6059m), back to BC; camping.
- Day 12: Contingency day in Base Camp for weather, camping.
- Day 13: Trek from BC to Ngawal (3660m-7 Hrs.); lodge.
- Day 14: Trek from Ngawal to Manang (3540-5 Hrs.); lodge.
- Day 15: Trek from Manang to Leddar (4050m-6 Hrs.);lodge.
- **Day 16:** Trek from Leddar to Throng Phedi (4540m-5 Hrs.)/High camp (4880m-7 Hrs.); lodge.
- Day 17: Trek via Throng-La Pass (5416m) to Muktinath (3710m); lodge.
- Day 18: Trek from Muktinath to Jomsom (2720m-5 Hrs.) via Kagbeni; lodge.
- Day 19: Fly from Jomsom to Pokhara (20 minutes), explore Pokhara city;Hotel.
- Day 20: Drive to Kathmandu (7 Hours), hotel transfer

Day 21: End of the Program/Fly to your destination.

Service Include:

- All arrival and departure transfers to and from Airports. •
- 3 Nights hotel accommodations in Kathmandu on BB Plan.
- 1 night Hotel accommodation in Pokhara on BB plan. •
- Experienced trekking guide (s) and 1:1 porter (s) during the trekking carrying 30kg maximum weight.
- Experienced and certified peak climbing Sherpa as per required. •
- Surface transportation for Kathmandu-Besi Sahar-Dharapani and VV or Pokhara to • Kathmandu.
- Jomsom-Pokhara flight tickets to all members and guide and surface to the porter (s). •
- Base camp camping equipment like camp furniture, kitchenware, tents, etc.
- 3 meals a day (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) and sharing teahouse accommodation during trekking.
- 3 meals a day (BLD with tea or coffee) and sharing tented camp accommodation during • climbing at BC.
- Necessary high altitude food for climbing member and Sherpa for high camps.

- Annapurna Conservation Area entry fees and TIMS (Trekkers' Information management system) card.
- Climbing permit for Chulu East Peak from Nepal Mountaineering Association (NMA).
- All wages, equipment, medical and accidental Insurances for the involved staffs.
- First Aid medical kits for the Group and the staffs.
- Required fixed and dynamic rope during climbing period through climbing Sherpa.
- All necessary paper works, and Government Taxes levied in Nepal
- Complete pre-departure information, flight ticket reconfirmation.
- Farewell dinner in a typical Nepali restaurant with domestic culture show in Kathmandu.

Service Exclude:
