# **Snowy-Mera Peak Climbing (6574m)**


Altitude: 6,574 Meters, Duration: 17/20 Days, Grade: Strenuous Trekking Peak

#### **Overview:**

"Join us on an unforgettable trip to Mera Peak – one of the 'most popular trekking peaks' in Nepal. Conveniently located in the Barun region, the climb can be easily combined with a trekking tour of the region."

Mera Peak (6654m) lies within the Everest Region and is one of the most popular trekking peaks in Nepal. The summit offers a stunning vista of five 8000m peaks: Mt. Everest, Lhotse, Cho Oyo, Makalu, and Kanchenjunga. Several other beautiful peaks and mountains can also be viewed from the summit – of course, weather permitting.

The route from the north is suitable even for climbers with less experience. However, it involves traversing a glacier at high altitude. The western ascent as well as the south face is more difficult and suitable for experienced climbers. Due to climate change, the conditions on the summit block have become more difficult over the years. Nevertheless, the normal route is still reasonably straightforward with minimal technical difficulties (F/PD). The main obstacle is the proper acclimatization to the altitude. You can rely on us to carefully design the schedule for an optimal acclimatization. Though Mera Peak is one of the highest trekking peaks in Nepal, it would also be suitable for a climber visiting the Himalayas for the first time given a sufficient level of physical fitness. Keen hill walkers with some experience using crampons and ice-axe are well suited for this adventure. We are happy to offer you advice if you have any doubts or require any tips for your preparations.

### Day-to-Day Itinerary: (Option 1)

Day 01: Arrival at Kathmandu Airport and transfer to hotel

Day 02: Briefing and drive to Mulkot (570m-95 Km.-3 Hrs.) (Way to Ramechhap); hotel.

**Day 03:** Drive to Manthali (475m), fly to Lukla (2837m) trek to Chhutang (3020m-2 Hrs.); lodge.

Day 04: Trek from Chhutang to Thuli Kharka (3900m-6 Hrs.) via Zatrawa La Pass (4610m); lodge.

**Day 05:** Trek from Thuli Kharka to Kothe (4095m-5 Hrs.); lodge.


**Day 06:** Trek from Kothe to Thangnak (4,350m-5 Hrs.); lodge.


**Day 07:** Rest and acclimatization day at Thangnak, explore and hiking.

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Day 09: Rest, preparation and acclimatization day at Khare.

**Day 10:** Trek to Mera Peak High Camp (5700m-5 Hrs.) from Khare, camping

Day 11: Summit Days; Mera High Camp to Summit (6,654m-10 Hrs.) and return to Khare.

Day 12: Contingency day for weather condition.

**Day 13:** Trek from Khare to Kothe (4095m-6 Hrs.).

Day 14: Trek from Kothe to Thuli Kharka (3900m-5 Hrs.).

Day 15: Trek from Thuli Kharka to Lukla (2850m-7 Hrs.); lodge.

Day 16: Fly to Ramechhap, drive to Katmandu (5 Hrs.), transfer to Hotel; farewell dinner.

Day 17: Contingency or leisure day in Kathmandu; hotel.

**Day 18:** Transfer to the airport for your final destination.

Day 06:Trek Phangum La-Pass (3174m) to Sherpa Village-Dzomshawa (2800m-6Hrs.); lodge.

Day 07:Trek from Sherpa Village to Bamboo/Jungle Camp (3150m)/Kudki (3700m-7 Hrs.); lodge.

Day 08: Trek from Jungle Camp/Kudki to Kothe (Hinku-Tal-3540m-6 Hrs.), teahouse.

Day 09: Trek from Kothe to Thangnak (4,350m-6 Hrs.); lodge.

Day 10: Rest and acclimatization day at Thangnak.

**Day 11:** Trek from Thangnak to Khare (5,045m-4 Hrs.); lodge.

**Day 12:** Rest, preparation and acclimatization day at Khare.

Day 13: Trek to Mera Peak High Camp (5700m-5 Hrs.) from Khare, camping

Day 14: Summit Days; Mera High Camp to Summit (6,654m-10 Hrs.) and return to Khare.

**Day 15:** Contingency day for weather condition.

Day 16: Trek from Khare to Kothe (4095m-6 Hrs.).

Day 17: Trek from Kothe to Thuli Kharka (3900m-5 Hrs.).

Day 18: Trek from Thuli Kharka to Lukla (2850m-7 Hrs.); lodge.
